

Fall 2010 WHEU East Coast Performance Tour

Trip Information

How do I sign up? The initial deposit is \$200 and should be received by Feb. 1 to reserve a spot. Three forms must be turned in with the deposit: WHEU Application, Universal Odyssey Participation Agreement (2 pages), and the TUSD Permission Slip (students only). All forms can be found at www.whsentertainmentunit.com

Checks should be written to WHEUPA Trip. If you need the mailing address, check your email or send an email to wheupa@gmail.com requesting the address.

What is the payment plan? After we receive your deposit and paperwork, we will send you payment information. Monthly payments will be due the first of each month, except for the last payment which will be due September 15.

What is the cost? The trip is \$2000 for students, \$2440 for adults. If you need additional pricing information (sibling sharing a room with parents, single room, etc.) email wheupa@gmail.com.

How much additional money will the students need? Students will need additional money for lunch each day, snacks, and anything else they wish to purchase. About \$200 is recommended. Additional money will be needed for some optional activities: Radio City Music Hall Backstage Tour, Ice Skating.

Can we buy trip insurance? Yes. See 'information on trip insurance' at www.whsentertainmentunit.com. If you have a preexisting medical condition and wish to purchase Travel Protection, you must purchase within 2 weeks of making your initial trip deposit.

Can parents book their own flights and pay their own airfare? Yes. Email wheupa@gmail.com to ask for trip pricing information without airfare. Travelers who don't fly with the group will be responsible for any expenses incurred meeting up with the group.

Can we use a credit card to pay for the trip? Yes. There is a 3% fee for credit card payments.

What will be the ratio of chaperones to students? There will be approximately 1 chaperone for every 15 students.

Does my student have to attend the trip to participate in the Entertainment Unit in Fall 2010? NO - this trip is optional.

Are there any academic eligibility requirements? Students must be eligible based on June grades to attend the trip. (At least a 2.0 grade point average, no more than 1 U).

What should I pack? There will be a meeting in the fall that will cover information about packing.

When do we bring our luggage? There will be a 'packing night' one or two nights before the trip when everyone will bring their luggage to West.

How do we get to and from the airport? Everyone will meet at West High and take busses to LAX. Upon return, travelers will be bussed back to West High.

My child has to try out for Tall Flags / Drill Team / Drumline in the spring. Should we sign up? Yes. Pay your \$200 deposit and fill out the paperwork. We will save you a space and refund your money if your child does not make it. If we have a waiting list for the trip before tryouts we may have to amend this policy but we will inform you of any changes and will not obligate you to any payments without your approval of our policy.
